The Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) is a highly regarded qualification recognized by universities and employers worldwide. At Sauder Academy, we are proud to offer this prestigious diploma through our flexible and comprehensive online learning platform.

To earn the OSSD, students must complete the following requirements:

18 Compulsory Credits*:

- 4 Credits in English (1 credit per grade)
- 3 Credits in Mathematics (at least 1 credit in Grade 11 or 12)
- 2 Credits in Science
- 1 Credit in Canadian History
- 1 Credit in Canadian Geography
- 1 Credit in the Arts
- 1 Credit in Health and Physical Education
- 1 Credit in French as a Second Language
- 0.5 Credit in Career Studies
- 0.5 Credit in Civics
- 12 Optional Credits

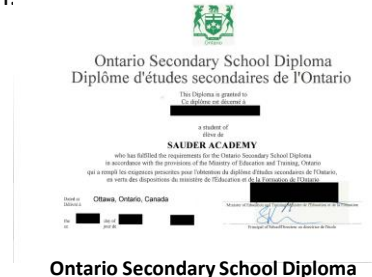
Literacy Requirement:

Students must pass the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT) or complete the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Course (OSSLC).

Community Involvement:

Students must complete a minimum of 40 hours of community service. This encourages students to contribute to their communities and develop a sense of social responsibility.

* Starting September 2024, students must earn one credit in Technological Education (Grade 9 or 10) as part of their Ontario Secondary School Diploma. Students will earn a total of 19 compulsory credits and 11 optional credits. This requirement starts with students entering Grade 9 in September 2024 and will not affect any students already in high school (students starting Grade 10, 11 and 12 in September 2024)

Application Procedure

No TOEFL or IELTS is required for admission; however, students will be placed into the appropriate level of English studies based on the Sauder Academy English Assessment Exam or official IELTS/TOEFL scores if available.

4. PLAR (Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition):

Our admissions officer will conduct a PLAR assessment to evaluate your prior learning and assign appropriate credits towards your OSSD.

5. Discuss with Education Consular to Set Up an Individual Study Plan:

Meet with an education consular to discuss your academic goals and create a personalized study plan.

6. Course Enrollment:

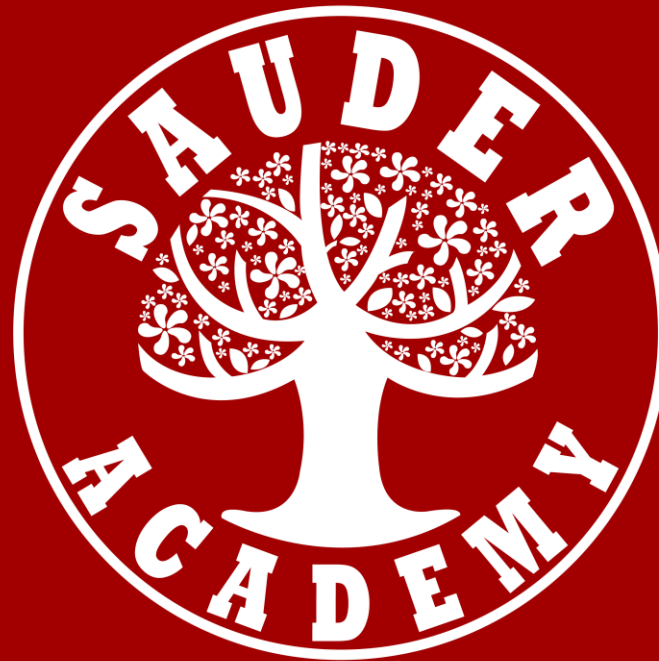
Once your study plan is finalized, enroll in your courses and start your journey at Sauder Academy.
